

Enrichment for content and more powerful animals

Spotmix Welfare

The EU Pig Farming Ordinance requires pig farmers to offer the animals enrichment toys to use for wallowing and playing. Since satisfied animals are also more efficient animals, this regulation is also basically in the interests of animals owners, but manual administration often causes a considerable amount of effort.

Spotmix Welfare, a functional extension of the proven Spotmix multi-phase feeding system, can now be used for bedding in the bays as well as shredded straw, sawdust chips, wood shavings, pelletized litter mats, bedding and shredding material in cab be distributed according to needs. Of course, the plant exhaust air treatment system can also be used for "sprinkling" and supplying material as an enrichment toy,

The enrichment material (with a maximum fiber length of 4 cm) is metered into the Spotmix delivery line from a special dispenser with spiral screw conveyor as "bypass" to any place in the stable where the enrichment material is to be offered. When the enrichment material is dispensed and the amount, dispensed is controlled the distribution is pneumatic

At each feeding point, the conveying air is separated from the working material over a cycle, so that the material reaches the desired setting site without significant

The maximum transporting capacity, is, for example, 60 kg / hour with chopped straw. For sawdust it is approx. 100 kg / hour. The maximum conveyor length is 200 m.

The plant exhaust air cleaning system, reduces the expenditure of, effort in supply of the material. The sytem can also be filled automatically via a bale breaker with a connected straw mill and dust extraction system..
